Position Description:

The Building Operator will be a member of the Facilities team and will report to the Facility Manager and will be responsible for the maintenance of the building and its mechanical systems.

The successful candidate will get satisfaction from a job well done and will enjoy figuring out the cause of a malfunctioning piece of equipment or facility problem and fixing it. Your process is careful and systematic, understanding that safety is vital for yourself, the members that swim and work out with us, the children being cared for, and your coworkers who make the YMCA a welcoming place. If you have experience with building maintenance or have graduated with a mechanical technician diploma or utility systems certificate, or related diploma, we welcome you to apply!

In this position, you will:

- Responsible for performing building and program equipment maintenance and repairs within the HFA branches of the YMCA in Hamilton, Burlington, and Brantford
- Co-ordinate outside trades people for repairs and maintenance performed on equipment and building systems as required
- Maintain equipment parts, inventory, and orders from recognized suppliers as required
- Will be required to maintain records of building, equipment and compliance requirements
- Carry out pool daily and annual maintenance (training will be provided)
- Provides a clean, safe and well-maintained facility to enhance the experience enjoyed by our members, volunteers, staff and other participants

- 2 year post-secondary education in Maintenance Services, Building Systems or Mechanical Maintenance Fundamentals OR trade certification OR equivalent work experience
- Experience in building trade preferably in one of the following areas:
 - Electrical/plumbing/carpentry
 - Mechanical & HVAC systems
